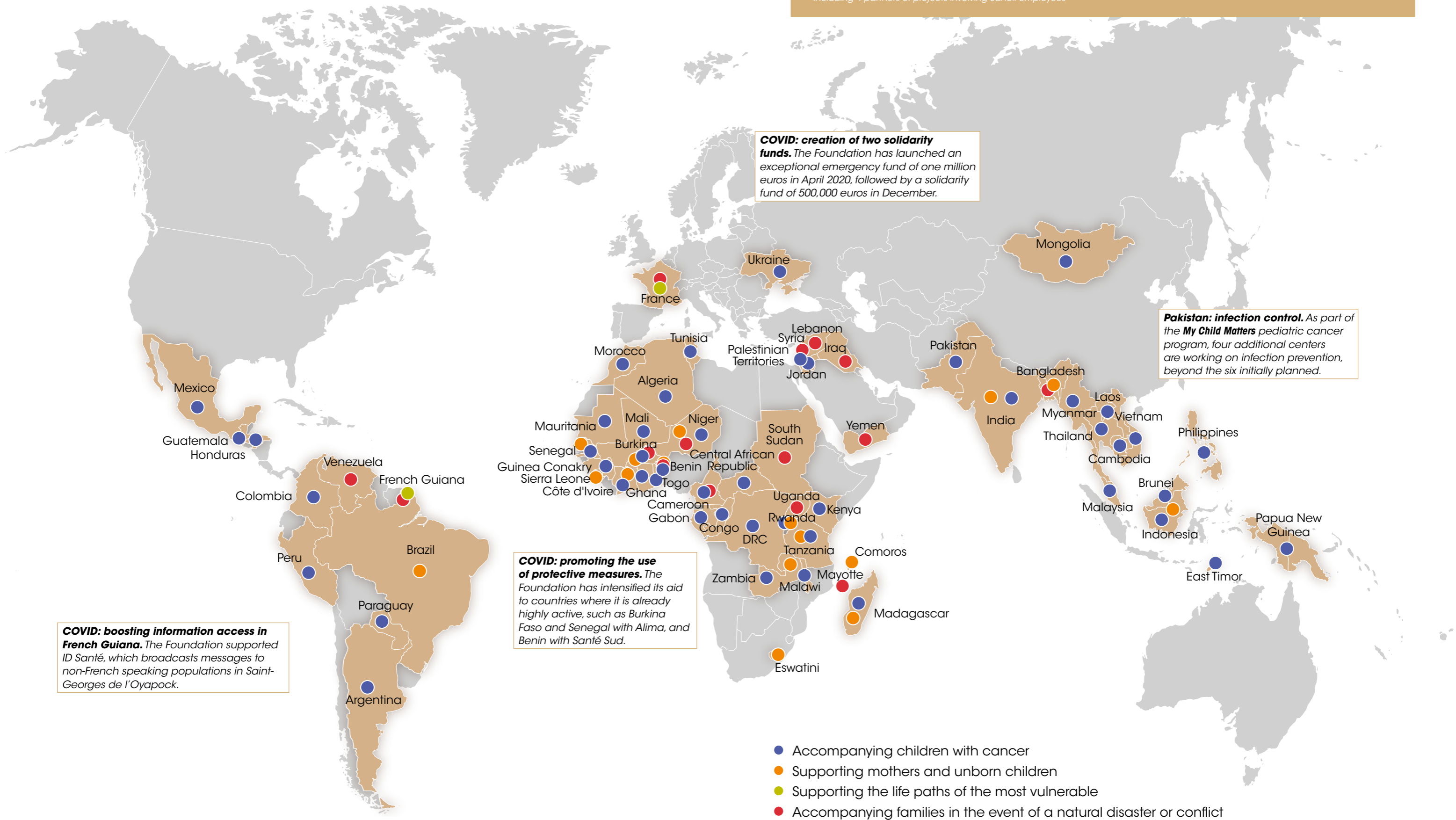

COVID: creation of two solidarity funds. The Foundation has launched an exceptional emergency fund of one million euros in April 2020, followed by a solidarity fund of 500,000 euros in December.

Pakistan: infection control. As part of the **My Child Matters** pediatric cancer program, four additional centers are working on infection prevention, beyond the six initially planned.

COVID: boosting information access in French Guiana. The Foundation supported **ID Santé**, which broadcasts messages to non-French speaking populations in Saint-Georges de l'Oyapock.

COVID: promoting the use of protective measures. The Foundation has intensified its aid to countries where it is already highly active, such as Burkina Faso and Senegal with **Alima**, and Benin with **Santé Sud**.
